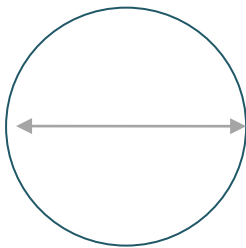


finding your ring size...

Measure against another ring

1. Grab a ring that fits the finger you want to measure
2. Using a ruler, measure as per example from the circle below, considering the distance between the internal sides.
3. The one that matches the closest is your ring size.



measure the distance
with a ruler

Size K - 15.9mm
 Size L - 16.3mm
 Size M - 16.7mm
 Size N - 17.1mm
 Size O - 17.5mm
 Size P - 17.9mm
 Size Q - 18.3mm
 Size R - 18.7mm
 Size S - 19.1mm
 Size T - 19.6mm
 Size U - 20.0mm
 Size V - 20.4mm
 Size W - 20.8mm

If you are
between sizes,
order the larger
size.

Tips and tricks

- Measure your finger at room temperature, be aware temperature, humidity and exercise can affect sizing
- If you measure your finger at its widest point (often the knuckle), get one size smaller to ensure your ring stays on
